



A wine of great historical importance, produced with grapes from a single plot of Sousão vines, which in the 1961 harvest marked the beginning of quality wine production in the Douro.

VITICULTURE
Grapes from a single vineyard plot at 270m, around 30 years old.

VINIFICATION
Fermentation with the whole bunch in a small stainless steel press with foot treading. Pressing at the end of alcoholic fermentation. Aged for 12 months in barrels and 2 years in bottle.

TASTING NOTE
Intense ruby colour, the aroma shows aromas of black fruit with balsamic and resinous notes. In the background, the complexity of spices from the barrel ageing. Firm but enveloping tannins emphasise the depth of the blend. Ageing in the bottle has softened it and made it even more complex and captivating.
